



## A new association supports women in their daily routine

The association "women for women in Stolberg" was found out of the community interest "women and girls in Velau" in October 2016 chaired by Mazeena Ismail who is vice chairwoman of the integration council in Stolberg.

It was founded not only to help women going to the authorities, to respond to their letters, to overcome the language barrier, but also to help in spontaneous matters. This association tries to assist mothers by running a caring group for children in which they are helped with their homework and taught the German language, so that the women have time to take care of other issues. Furthermore, the "women for women in Stolberg" teach especially women how to ride a bike. On and off different trips or adventures are planned with the 40-headed group. Monthly there is a great international breakfast every first Thursday in the "KUGEL" which is near Breslauer Straße. New offerings are presented and current ideas are produced.

The offers of the association are open for all women, but in the first place they are addressed to refugees and migrants. The meeting area is the KUGEL.
