



## Impressive result weighs up to 700 kilograms

In the district called "Alte Velau" a multicultural group of eight women created a 2 meters high and 700 kilograms heavy concrete sculpture which should symbolize unity, protection and human interaction. The sculpture consists of two embracing women representing the intention of creating the sculpture who are sitting on a ring which underlines the coherent entity.

This outstanding artwork was created in two and a half weeks. Besides the women's daily routine, kids and work, they worked six hours a day on their project which is a great accomplishment. This process was supported by the employment and qualification society called "low-tech" with tools and men power. Furthermore, it was accompanied by the artist Ria Geis from Stolberg and the artist Sebastian Schmidt.

Equally important are the development of a strong community spirit and the building of new friendships and a fully functional team. Even now the participants are close friends, although they did not know each other at the beginning. Concludingly one can say that the sculpture reflects: unity, protection and human interaction.
